Paper Roller Coaster rules

- 1. The Paper Roller Coaster's height should be no more than 36" tall.
- 2. You may only use the materials supplied to build the structure and the track. However, you may use any materials you would like for decorations. The roller coaster must be decorated.
- 3. Your Paper Roller Coaster must have a name which should be displayed prominently on your coaster or its base.
- 4. Marbles must consistently stay on the track and complete the entire track.
- 5. Marble must take at least 15 seconds to complete the track.
- 6. You may use no more than three funnels on your roller coaster.
